PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

Pursuant to Rule 65 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Plaintiffs Michael Andrew Rodgers and Glynn Dilbeck move this Court for a preliminary injunction. In support of this motion, Plaintiffs submit the following:

3. Declaration of Plaintiff Glynn Dilbeck, attached and incorporated as Exhibit 3;
4. Email from State Trooper Cpl. Aaron Keith, describing conduct of Plaintiff Dilbeck, which led to Ticket No. 2000317529, attached and incorporated as Exhibit 4;
5. Warning and citation records of the Arkansas State Police issued pursuant to §5-71-212(a)(3), attached and incorporated as Exhibit 5. This exhibit includes a warning and a citation for Plaintiff Dilbeck, respectively Warning No. W000328 and Ticket No. 2000317529, and

5. Plaintiffs' brief filed contemporaneous with this motion.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs respectfully request that this Court:

1. Issue a preliminary injunction restraining Defendant, his employees, agents and successors from enforcing §5-71-213(a)(3);

2. Enter a judgment declaring that §5-71-213(a)(3) on its face violates the United States Constitution;

3. Award Plaintiffs costs and attorneys' fees pursuant to 42 U.S.C. §1988; and

4. Grant such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper.

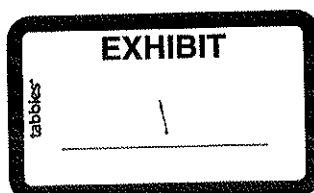

DECLARATION OF MICHAEL ANDREW RODGERS

MICHAEL ANDREW RODGERS hereby declares:


1. I am over the age of 21, competent, and have personal knowledge of the matters attested to in this declaration.
2. I am a disabled veteran and have resorted to begging in order to have enough money to live on.
3. When I beg, I do so by holding up a sign that identifies me as a veteran.
4. In 2015, I was arrested, put in jail and also received four additional citations, all under §5-71-213(a)(3). The Prosecuting Attorney voluntarily dismissed one charge against me. The District Court found me guilty on the other four charges, which were appealed to the Garland County Court. I have been required to post bond and pay court fees. The four remaining charges were dismissed by the Circuit Court, which found the law to be unconstitutional. There were no appeals of the dismissals. There presently is no criminal proceeding against me in any court in Arkansas.



5. Although, I am now able to beg in Garland County, I am afraid to do so outside of Garland County because of §5-71-213(a)(3). I am afraid of arrest, incarceration, charges, and criminal proceedings against me.

I DECLARE UNDER PENALTY OF PERJURY THAT THE FOREGOING IS TRUE AND CORRECT.

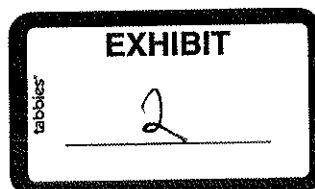

ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On June 6, 2016, this Court held a hearing on Defendant's Motion to Dismiss the loitering charges against him in the four captioned cases. Appearing before the Court at the hearing were attorneys Bettina E. Brownstein and Shane Etheridge in behalf of Defendant, sponsored by the Arkansas Civil Liberties Foundation, Inc., and Terri Harris, Prosecuting Attorney, Eighteenth Judicial District, for the Plaintiff. The basis for the motion was that the law under which the charges were brought, Ark. Code Ann. §5-71-213 (a) (3), is unconstitutional on its face under the First Amendment of the United States Constitution.

The Court finds that the arguments of Defendant's counsel and the law cited in the brief in support of the Motion to Dismiss to be persuasive. The Court has also considered the arguments of Plaintiff in its Response to the Motion to Dismiss. The Court finds that §5-71-213 (a) (3) is unconstitutional on its face as overbroad because as written it cannot be applied in a way as to avoid constitutional infirmity and it burdens substantially more speech than is necessary to further any legitimate interest. Begging is a constitutionally-protected form of speech because it involves the communication of information, dissemination, or the advocacy of causes. The law in question is content-based because it prohibits speech on the basis of its content – a request for money. As such, it fails the strict-scrutiny test, which is the applicable




test for a content-based restriction of speech, because it is not narrowly tailored to advance a compelling state interest. The state does not have a compelling interest in excluding those who beg in a peaceful manner. Even if the state could show a compelling interest, which it has not done, this law is not narrowly tailored because it bans all begging everywhere at all times.

Ark. Code Ann §5-71-213 (a) (3) is also unconstitutional because it is not a valid time, place and manner restriction in that it does not leave open ample, alternative channels of communication. It is a complete ban on all begging, even peaceful begging.


Finally, Ark. Code Ann §5-71-213 (a) (3) is unconstitutional because it bans protected speech in traditional public fora, such as sidewalks, parks and other places historically held open for speech.

THEREFORE, based upon the law and arguments of Defendant, as set forth in the Motion to Dismiss, Brief in Support of Motion to Dismiss, and the Response to Motion to Dismiss of Plaintiff, the Court finds that the motion is meritorious. For the reasons set for the in this order, the Court finds that Ark. Code Ann. § 5-71-213 (a) (3) is unconstitutional on its face and hereby ORDERS that the captioned cases BE AND HEREBY ARE DISMISSED.



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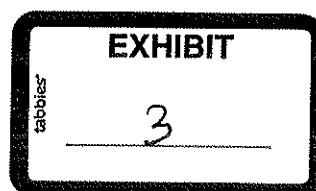

DECLARATION OF GLYNN DILBECK


GLYNN DILBECK hereby declares:

1. I am over the age of 21, competent, and have personal knowledge of the matters attested to in this declaration.
2. I have a very ill daughter and have resorted to begging in order to have enough money to live on and to help pay her medical bills.
3. When I beg, I do so by peacefully holding up a sign asking for money.
4. In September 2015, I received a citation under §5-71-213(a)(3) from an Arkansas State Trooper while I was holding up a sign asking for money alongside the exit to an interstate in Rogers, Arkansas. At trial in the District Court of Rogers, Arkansas, the Prosecuting Attorney voluntarily dismissed the charge against me. There is no appeal of the dismissal. There presently is no criminal proceeding against me in any court in Arkansas involving §5-71-213(a)(3).

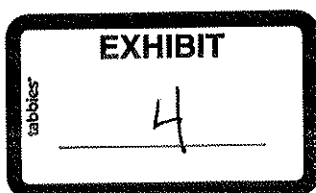

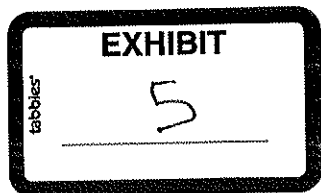

**PLAINTIFFS' BRIEF IN SUPPORT OF MOTION
FOR PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION**

I. INTRODUCTION

Pursuant to Rule 65 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Plaintiffs have filed a motion for preliminary injunction requesting that this Court preliminarily enjoin Defendant from enforcing Ark. Code Ann. § 5-71-213(a)(3), as it impermissibly abridges Plaintiffs' rights to free speech and due process, which are protected by the First and Fourteenth Amendments of the United States Constitution. The statute prohibits all begging anytime anywhere and is a vague, overbroad, content-based, restriction that leaves no suitable alternatives for the speech in question to be expressed. It criminalizes otherwise lawful conduct by restricting Plaintiffs' right to communicate to others their need for money or other charity.

Ark. Code Ann. § 5-71-213(a)(3) provides:

(a) A person commits the offense of loitering if he or she:

...

(3) Lingers or remains in a public place or on the premises of another for the purposes of begging.

II. SUMMARY OF ARGUMENT

The First Amendment to the United States Constitution prohibits Congress from making laws which abridge the freedom of speech. U.S. CONST. amend. I. The Fourteenth Amendment prohibit sa state from depriving any person of life, liberty, or property, without due process of law. U.S. CONST. amend. XIV. The Fourteenth Amendment extends application of the First Amendment to actions of the states. *Id.* Arkansas’ prohibition on begging violates the First Amendment because it is a content-based restriction on Plaintiffs’ freedom of speech which is not narrowly tailored to advance a compelling government interest nor does it give fair warning of which conduct is prohibited. Arkansas’ anti-begging statute bans **all** begging in **all** places at **all** times. It prohibits soliciting money itself without reference to any type of conduct. It makes it a crime to request the help of others without recompense, either verbally, with a gesture, or by using signage. In addition, the statute does not define the term “begging” and does not give fair notice as to what conduct is prohibited. It thus violates Plaintiffs’ ‘free speech and due process rights.

Plaintiffs have engaged in begging in a completely peaceful and non-threatening manner on several occasions in this state. They beg as a means of earning a living and in Plaintiff Dilbeck’s case, also to help pay his daughter’s medical bills.

In 2015, Plaintiff Rodgers was arrested by the Hot Springs, Arkansas police, put in jail and in addition, received four separate citations, all for violations of §5-71-213(a)(3). See Exhibit 1, ¶4 to Motion for Preliminary Injunction. He was required to post a bond to be released from jail and incurred additional court costs and fees. The Prosecuting Attorney for the 18th Judicial

District dismissed one charge. The Garland County District Court found Mr. Rodgers guilty on the four other charges. Upon appeals *de novo*, these remaining charges were dismissed by the Garland County Circuit Court, when it ruled that §5-71-213(a)(3) is unconstitutional. See Exhibit 2 to Motion for Preliminary Injunction. Although Plaintiff Rodgers might now be able to beg in Garland County, he is still subject to arrest or citation anywhere outside of Garland County. He therefore refrains from begging for fear of arrest, incarceration, charges and criminal proceedings against him. He wishes to continue to beg as a means of livelihood but is prevented from doing by the anti-begging law. He thus has standing to bring this action and is entitled to a preliminary injunction prohibiting enforcement of this law because he meets the four-part *Dataphase* test applied in this circuit. *Dataphase Sys., Inc. v. C L Sys., Inc.*, 640 F.2d 109, 114 (8th Cir. 1981) (*en banc*)).

Plaintiff Dilbeck was cited by the Arkansas State Police on September 10, 2015 for holding up a sign asking for money. See Exhibits 3, ¶4, and 4 to the Motion for Preliminary Injunction. The charge was subsequently voluntarily dismissed by the Prosecuting Attorney for the 19th Judicial District. Although he would continue to beg, he is afraid to do so for fear of citation, arrest, incarceration, charges and criminal proceedings against him. Plaintiff Dilbeck also has standing to bring this action and is entitled to a preliminary injunction prohibiting enforcement of this law because he meets the *Dataphase* test.

III. ARGUMENT

A. Plaintiffs Have Standing.

To maintain an action in federal court, each Plaintiff must show: (1) he has “suffered an injury-in-fact”; (2) the injury is “fairly . . . trace[able] to the challenged action of the defendant”;

and (3) it is “likely, as opposed to merely speculative, that the injury will be redressed by a favorable decision.” *Lujan v. Defenders of Wildlife*, 504 U.S. 555, 560-61 (1992).

In *Harmon v. Kansas City*, 197 F.3d 321 (8th Cir. 1999), the Eighth Circuit articulated the test for asserting an as-applied statutory challenge: standing to challenge a statute or ordinance as applied is present when the challenger has experienced a direct injury or will soon sustain a direct injury redressable by the court. *Id.* at 326 (citing *See Alexander v. City of Minneapolis*, 928 F.2d 278, 281-82 (8th Cir. 1991); *Valley Forge Christian College v. Americans United for Separation of Church & State, Inc.*, 454 U.S. 464, 472 (1982)); *Postscript Enter., Inc. v. Westfall*, 771 F.2d 1132, 1135-36 (8th Cir. 1985)). “[I]t is not necessary that [the Plaintiff] first expose himself . . . to actual arrest or prosecution to be entitled to challenge a statute that he . . . claims deters the exercise of his . . . constitutional rights.” *Id.* (quoting *Steffel v. Thompson*, 415 U.S. 452, 459 (1974)).

Plaintiffs meet the *Lujan* and *Harmon* tests. They have suffered actual injury from the application of an unconstitutional statute in the past, fear suffering actual injury in the future due to its enforcement by Defendant, and the threat of future injury will be redressed by a favorable decision by this Court. Defendant’s employees routinely warn and cite individuals around the state for begging in violation of § 5-71-213(a)(3) that later result in criminal prosecutions against these individuals. See Exhibits 3 and 4 to the Motion for Preliminary Injunction. As a result of this reality and their prior experiences, Plaintiffs fear actual injury in the future if they continue to beg. This fear is real and not speculative.

In addition, Plaintiffs have standing to bring and do bring a facial challenge to the statute. *See Schaumburg*, 444 U.S. at 634. (“Litigant whose own activities are unprotected may nevertheless challenge a statute by showing that it substantially abridges the First Amendment

rights of other parties not before the court.”) In this instance, however, the litigants also have standing due to their own activities and actual injuries.

B. The Preliminary Injunction Standard.

In determining whether Plaintiffs are entitled to a preliminary injunction, the relevant factors are: “(1) the probability of success on the merits; (2) the threat of irreparable injury to the movant; (3) the balance between this harm and the injury that granting the injunction will inflict on other interested parties; and (4) whether the issuance of an injunction is in the public interest.” *Dataphase Sys., Inc.* 640 F.2d at 114. However, “[w]hen a Plaintiff has shown a likely violation of his or her First Amendment rights, the other requirements for obtaining a preliminary injunction are generally deemed to have been satisfied.” *Phelps–Roper v. Troutman*, 662 F.3d 485, 488 (8th Cir.2011). It is well-settled law that a “loss of First Amendment freedoms, for even minimal periods of time, unquestionably constitutes irreparable injury.” *Elrod v. Burns*, 427 U.S. 347, 373 (1976) (plurality). If Plaintiffs can establish a sufficient likelihood of success on the merits of their First Amendment claims, they will also have established irreparable harm. *Phelps-Roper v. Nixon*, 545 F.3d 685, 689-90 (8th Cir. 2008) (internal quotations omitted), *overruled on other grounds by Phelps-Roper v. City of Manchester*, 697 F. 2d. 678 (8th Cir. 2012); see also *Marcus v. Iowa Pub. Television*, 97 F.3d 1137, 1140-41 (8th Cir.1996); *Kirkeby v. Furness*, 52 F.3d 772, 775 (8th Cir. 1995). The balance of equities, too, generally favors constitutionally-protected freedom of expression, *Nixon*, 645 F.3d at 691, and it is always in the public interest to protect constitutional rights. *Id.*; see also *Connection Distrib. Co. v. Reno*, 154 F.3d 281, 288 (6th Cir.1998) (quotations omitted); *Kirkeby*, 52 F.3d at 775 (citing *Frisby v. Schultz*, 487 U.S. 474, 479 (1988)).

C. Plaintiffs Are Likely To Succeed On The Merits.

At this stage of the proceedings, the role of the Court is not to determine the constitutionality of the begging statute but rather the likelihood of Plaintiffs' success in prevailing on his challenge. *See Glenwood Bridge, Inc. v. City of Minneapolis*, 940 F.2d 367, 371 (8th Cir.1991). (In considering the likelihood of the movant prevailing on the merits, a court does not decide whether the movant "will ultimately win"). Because Plaintiffs are challenging the constitutionality of a state statute, they must demonstrate that they are likely "to prevail on the merits." *Planned Parenthood Minn., N.D., S.D. v. Rounds*, 530 F.3d 725, 732 (2008). Under *Dataphase* and *Rounds*, Plaintiffs can show likelihood of success on the merits.

1. Begging is a constitutionally-protected form of speech.

The United States Supreme Court has long protected speech in the form of solicitation for money. *Schaumburg v. Citizens for Better Env't*, 444 U.S. at 833 (citing *New York Times Co. v. Sullivan*, 1376 U.S. 254 (1964); *Bates v. States Bar of Arizona*, 433 U.S. 350, 363 (1977)). In *Schaumburg*, the Supreme Court held unconstitutional a city ordinance which prohibited solicitations without a permit because charitable solicitations include a variety of speech interests that are within the protection of the First Amendment. *Schaumburg*, 444 U.S. at 833. Such interests include the communication of information, the dissemination and propagation of views and ideas, and the advocacy of causes. *Id.* Begging, like charitable solicitations, involves substantial speech interests and is thus protected by the First Amendment. *See Speet v. Schuette*, 726 F.3d 867, 878 (6th Cir. 2013) (holding Michigan's anti-begging statute an unconstitutional violation of the First Amendment); *Clatterbuck v. City of Charlottesville*, 708 F.3d 549, 553 (4th Cir. 2012) ("the speech and expressive conduct that comprise begging merit First Amendment Protection"); *Gresham v. Peterson*, 225 F.3d 899, 904 (7th Cir. 2000) ("the Court's analysis in

Schaumburg suggests little reason to distinguish between beggars and charities in terms of the First Amendment’s protection of their speech”); *Smith v. City of Fort Lauderdale*, 177 F.3d 954, 956 (11th Cir. 1999) (agreeing that begging is speech entitled to First Amendment Protection); *Loper v. New York City Police Dep’t*, 999 F.2d 699, 704 (2nd Cir. 1993) (finding that the distinction between begging and charitable solicitations “is not a significant one for First Amendment purposes.”); *Redondo Beach v. City of Redondo Beach*, 657 F.3d 936, 945 (9th Cir. 2011) (striking down an ordinance that disallowed requesting money from motor vehicles because such solicitation “constitutes protected expression under the First Amendment”); *ACLU of Nevada v. City of Las Vegas*, 466 F.3d 784, 792 (9th Cir. 2006) (ordinance prohibiting begging violated First Amendment because “solicitation is a form of expression entitled to the same constitutional protections as traditional speech.”)

Courts have found no real distinction between the type of speech involved in charitable solicitations and that involved in begging, since in the former the solicitation is on behalf of others and in the latter the solicitation is on behalf of one’s self. *See Loper*, 999 F.2d at 704 (“We see little difference between those who solicit for organized charities and those who solicit for themselves in regard to the message conveyed.”). “Begging is indistinguishable from charitable solicitation for First Amendment purposes [and to] hold otherwise would mean that an individual’s plight is worthy of less protection in the eyes of the law than the interests addressed by an organized group.” *Speet*, 726 F.3d at 867.

Though not all begging conveys the various protected speech interests enumerated in *Schaumburg*—communication of information, the dissemination and propagation of views and ideas, and the advocacy of causes— it usually does involve *some* communication of that nature. *See Schaumburg*, 444 U.S. at 833; *Loper*, 999 F.2d at 704 (emphasis added). The very nature of

begging inherently communicates important political or social messages related to the individual's need for food, shelter, transportation or care such as one's veteran status, unemployment, homelessness, and disability. *See Gresham v. Peterson*, 225 F.3d at 905; *Loper*, 999 F.2d at 704. Even absent particularized speech, the very image of a homeless person itself conveys a message of need for support and assistance. *Id.* "While some communities might wish all solicitors, beggars and advocates of various causes be vanished from the streets, the First Amendment guarantees their right to be there, deliver their pitch, and ask for support." *Gresham*, 225 F.3d at 905.

Thus, because there is little difference between solicitations by charitable organizations and those made by the indigent *and* because the U.S. Supreme Court has held that charitable solicitations constitute free speech under the protections guaranteed by the First Amendment, Arkansas' statute prohibiting begging restricts constitutionally-protected free speech.

State courts analyzing similar laws have also invalidated them as unconstitutional under the First Amendment. *See e.g., People v. Hoffstead*, 905 N.Y.S.2d 736 (N.Y. App. Term, 2010); *Benedict v. City of Cambridge*, 679 N.E. 2d 185 (Mass. 1997); *Ledford v. N.Y. City Police Dpt.*, 999 F.2d 699 (C.A. 2 (N.Y.) 1993)). The Garland County Circuit Court has ruled that the very statute challenged in this action is unconstitutional. *See* Exhibit 2 to the Motion for Preliminary Injunction.

2. Ark. Code Ann. § 5-71-213(a)(3) fails strict scrutiny because it is a content-based restriction that is not narrowly tailored to advance a compelling state interest.

When a statute is content-based, the appropriate test to apply is strict scrutiny. *Clatterbuck*, 708 F.3d at 555. Under this test, the statute may only be upheld only if it is narrowly tailored to further a compelling government interest. *Id.*

A distinction is content-based if it distinguishes content, valuing some forms of speech over others to distort public debate, to restrict expression because of its message, its ideas, its subject matter, or to prohibit the expression of an idea simply because society finds the idea itself offensive or disagreeable. *Id.* at 556. The Eighth Circuit has stated that “the principal inquiry in determining content neutrality in speech case, generally, and in time, place or manner cases, in particular, is whether the government has adopted a regulation of speech because of disagreement with the message it conveys.” *Frye v. Kansas City Missouri Police Dept.* 373 F.3d 785, 790 (8th Cir. 2004) (quoting *Hill v. Colorado*, 530 U.S. 703, 719)). Restrictions on speech are presumptively invalid, and the government bears the burden to rebut the presumption. *U.S. v. Playboy Entm’t Group*, 529 U.S. 803, 816 (2000). The Arkansas statute at issue is content-based because the state legislature disagrees that people should be allowed to request money or other charity from others. It prohibits all speech related to begging and in doing so, it makes a distinction between requests for charity and other forms of expression -- such as those made by politicians asking for a vote, or anyone else holding up a sign with a message if not asking for charity. Prohibitions on begging serve to silence both speech and conduct on the basis of the message itself (a request for assistance) while leaving other types of messages untouched. *Loper*, 999 F.2d at 705.

Arkansas does not have a compelling interest in excluding those who beg in a peaceful manner from communicating with their fellow citizens when none of the popularly presumed “evils” that are associated with begging are present and can be addressed with other existing laws. Moreover, even if Arkansas does have a compelling interest in preventing the evils sometimes associated with begging, “a statute that totally prohibits begging everywhere cannot be considered ‘narrowly tailored’ to achieve that end.” *See Id.* (holding that a New York statute

very similar to Arkansas' was not narrowly tailored to a compelling interest). In addition, when laws exist independent of the statute at issue which serve to curb the evils associated with begging, such as those proscribing harassment, intimidation, and fraud, or road safety, *see e.g.*, Ark. Code Ann. §§ 5-71-207, 208, 209, 213(a)(1), 214, a law which prevents an individual from peacefully requesting assistance is overbroad because it unnecessarily stifles speech unrelated to any legitimate government interest. *See id.* at 705-06. *See Schaumburg*, 444 U.S. at 637.

Thus, the statute at issue prohibits conduct on the basis of its content and Arkansas does not have a compelling government interest in prohibiting begging that is not already served by other statutes aimed at alleviating the presumed potential evils of begging, the statute at issue fails strict scrutiny and is unconstitutional. And, even assuming there is a compelling government interest at stake (which Plaintiffs do not concede), § 5-71-213(a)(3) is not narrowly-tailored to further that interest. Therefore, it fails the strict scrutiny test.

3. Section 5-71-213(a)(3) is unconstitutional even as a time, place and manner restriction because it is not content-neutral and does not leave open ample, alternative channels of communication.

Arkansas' prohibition against loitering with the intent to beg can only pass constitutional muster if the prohibition is necessary to serve a compelling state interest and is narrowly tailored to achieve that end; *or*, the prohibition can be characterized as a regulation of the time, place and manner of expression that is content neutral, is narrowly tailored to serve significant government interests and leaves open alternative channels of communication. *Loper*, 999 F. 2d at 704-705 (citing *Perry Educ. Ass'n v. Perry Local Educators Ass'n*, 460 U.S. 37, 45 (1987)). The statute is an unconstitutional restriction on an individual's right to beg because even if the statute serves a substantial government interest and is deemed narrowly-tailored (which Plaintiffs do not concede), it is not content neutral and does not leave individuals with ample, alternative channels

of communication. Thus, it cannot possibly be upheld as a permissible time, place, and manner restriction.

In *Loper*, the Second Circuit held a statute very similar to Arkansas' to be unconstitutional. *Id.* Although the court believed the statute was content-based because it prohibited all speech related to begging, the court found that even if the statute were analyzed as a restriction on the time, place and manner of expression, it would still fail because its total prohibition did not leave open alternative channels of communication. *Id.* at 705. Like the statute at issue in *Loper*, the Arkansas statute prohibits loitering in **all public places** as well as on privately-owned property. *Cf. Smith v. City of Fort Lauderdale*, 177 F.3d 954 (11th Cir. 1999). In *Smith*, the Eleventh Circuit upheld a law restricting begging within the Fort Lauderdale Beach area noting the city's significant interest in promoting its tourism industry. *Id.* However, in doing so, the court also noted that Fort Lauderdale's law left open ample alternative channels of communication because it allowed begging on streets, sidewalks, and in many other public places throughout the city. *Id.* at 956-57. Unlike the law at issue in *Smith*, the statute here does not leave open *any* alternative channels of communication, much less "ample" ones. Thus, because it restricts constitutionally-protected speech without leaving open an alternative means such expression, it is not a permissible time, manner and place restriction but rather is an unconstitutional restriction of individuals' freedom of speech.

4. Arkansas' anti-begging law bans speech in traditional public fora.

Section 5-71-213(a)(3) bans begging in all public places. In doing so, it prohibits a specific kind of speech in all public fora, including those traditionally held out as public, such as sidewalks, parks and other places historically held open for speech. "Streets, sidewalks, parks, and other similar public places are so historically associated with the exercise of First

Amendment rights that access to them for the purpose of exercising such rights cannot constitutionally be denied broadly and absolutely.” *Hudgens v. NLRB*, 424 U.S. 507, 515 (1976). To withstand a constitutional challenge to the validity of a law that bans all begging in public fora, Defendant must show that its regulation is necessary to serve a compelling state interest and that it is narrowly drawn to achieve that end.” *Perry Educ. Ass’n v. Perry Local Educators’ Ass’n.*, 460 U.S. 37, 45 (1983). Additionally, when restricting speech in public places, the government must “leave open alternative channels for communication.” *Ward v. Rock Against Racism*, 491 U.S. 781, 789 (1989). Section 5-71-213(a)(3) meets none of these tests.

5. Section 5-71-213(a) is void for vagueness

A statute defining an offense for which one may be punished is void for vagueness under due process standards, unless it gives one of ordinary intelligence fair notice that his contemplated conduct is forbidden, so he may act accordingly.” *Papachristou v. City of Jacksonville*, 405 U.S. 156, 162 (1972); see also, *Grayned v. City of Rockford*, 408 U.S. 104, 108 (1972). A criminal statute which does not furnish a sufficiently ascertainable standard of guilt does not meet constitutional due process requirements. *Herndon v. Lowry*, 301 U.S. 242 (1937). Moreover, “A law’s failure to provide fair notice of what constitutes a violation is a special concern where laws ‘abut upon sensitive areas of basic First Amendment freedoms.’” *Stahl v. City of St. Louis, Missouri*, 687 F.3d 1038, 1041 (8th Cir, 2012).

Section 5-71-213(a) does not define “begging.” It is not defined in any related law. Black’s Law Dictionary, Thompson, West, (8th ed. 2004) defines “beg” as “to request earnestly, beseech” or “to ask for charity, especially habitually or pitiably.” “Charity” is defined as “aid given to the poor, the suffering, or the general community for religious, educational, economic, public safety, or medical purposes.” *Id.* The possibilities for violation of the anti-begging law

appear endless. The law may be interpreted to prohibit organizations from soliciting monetary contributions for firemen, police, political candidates, or student sports organizations. It may be interpreted to extend to forms of aid beyond money or food. The law is not clear and “does not provide fair notice as to what conduct is forbidden.” *Stahl*, 687 F. 3d at 1041.

6. Section 5-71-213(a) is facially invalid as overbroad.

Section 5-71-213(a) is invalid as overbroad on its face. As written, it can never be applied in a way as to avoid constitutional infirmity because it burdens substantially more speech than necessary to further any legitimate government interest. *Bd. of Tr. of State Univ. of New York*, 492 U.S. at 478 (1989); *Phelps-Roper*, 545 F. 3d at 692. It affects the First Amendment rights of **everyone** who would beg except for § 5-71-213(a)(3). Therefore, it is subject to a facial challenge.

Arkansas State Troopers routinely issue warnings and citations under the anti-begging law. See Exhibit 5 to the motion for preliminary injunction. Under Supreme Court decisions, Plaintiffs may bring a facial challenge to assert the rights of others to beg in this state. For this additional reason, this law is subject to a facial challenge.

D. Plaintiffs Will Suffer Irreparable Harm in the Absence of a Preliminary Injunction.

Plaintiffs will suffer irreparable harm if a preliminary injunction is not granted because their First Amendment rights are being abridged. *Phelps-Roper v. Nixon*, 509 F.3d 480, 488 (8th Cir. 2007.) There is no remedy at law which can compensate for the loss of this protected free speech rights. *Nat'l People's Action v. Village of Wilmette*, 914 F.2d. 1008, 1013 (7th Cir. 1990).

E. The Balance between This Harm and the Injury That Granting The Injunction Will Inflict On Other Interested Parties.

Here, the balance of equities tips decidedly in Plaintiffs' favor. *Nixon*, 509 F.3d at 488. In the absence of a preliminary injunction, enforcement of challenged provisions of the law will prevent Plaintiffs from exercising his First Amendment right. On the other hand, if the Court grants a preliminary injunction, Defendant will suffer no harm. Any interest government has in preventing the evils associated with begging can be addressed by other state laws, such as those proscribing harassment, intimidation, fraud, or road safety. Ark. Code Ann. §§ 5-71-207, 208, 209, 213(a)(1), and 214. *See Schaumburg*, 444 U.S. at 637.

F. The Public Interest.

Finally, the grant of a preliminary injunction would serve the public interest. It is axiomatic that the public interest is served by upholding the Constitution and preventing the enforcement of unconstitutional laws. *Nixon*, 509 F.3d 488 (8th Cir. 2007). Because the Act is unconstitutional, the public interest will be served by an injunction against it.

III.CONCLUSION

For the reasons set forth above, Plaintiffs respectfully request that the Court grant their motion for a preliminary injunction and enjoin Defendant from enforcing the begging law during the pendency of this litigation.
